2) Do Your History and Exam

Pediatric Assessment Triangle

Birth History

Eating/Drinking/Peeing/Pooping

Immunization Status

EXAM === Check the Groin!

3) The 5 BIG Tests

Finger Stick Blood Glucose

Urinalysis

Chest X-Ray

Abdominal X-Ray

Abdominal Ultrasound

4) Treatment

Tylenol - Fever

Zofran - Vomiting

NOTHING - Diarrhea

Pedialyte - Hydration
